

Communicating with children about big emotions can be difficult. A child's developing brain is imaginative, creative and beautiful. They communicate through play and metaphor rather than the verbal language of adults.

This book discusses the issue of difference through the story of Chalky the Chihuahua, who realises as he grows up that he is much smaller than all his friends. This sees him plummet into sadness and isolation as he questions his use, strengths and whether he has a superpower.

It explores themes of friendship, loneliness, isolation, sadness, hopelessness and helplessness, whilst Magical Maisie and Chalky's friends help him discover his strengths and superpower through story.

Some children can appear fixated on a story and want it read over and over. Bear with them, they are strongly identifying with an aspect of the story and are processing this difficulty through repetition.






# Magical Maisie
